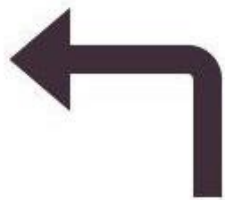


Directions

Turn left



Turn right



Go straight

We use these prepositions to indicate the location of something

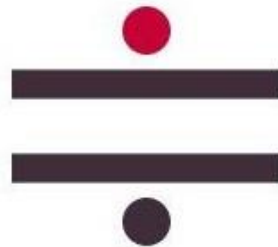
Prepositions of place
